REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Village of East Aurora is seeking proposals from qualified engineering firms for the following services:

- engineering design for full reconstruction of Oakwood Avenue;
- engineering design for replacement of the Oakwood Avenue waterline;
- engineering design for storm water improvements on Oakwood Avenue;
- creation of bid plans and specifications for all of the above.

Proposals may also include the following additional alternate items:

- construction management for all of the above;
- engineering design for fiber optic cable;
- engineering design for conduit for fiber optic cable to be installed in the future;
- engineering design moving underground all existing above-ground utilities;
- creation of bid plans and specifications for the above additional alternate items;
- construction management for the above additional alternate items.

Some basic specifications for the project are as follows:

- The total project length is estimated at 5,913 feet, with a pavement width of 30 feet.
- The water main is to be 8-inch ductile iron pipe and the related work includes service connections for all properties and new fire hydrants.
- For storm water improvements, plans are to increase the current 18-inch line to a 24-inch line, and also redirect the line down Oakwood Avenue from Sycamore Street.
- Coordination shall occur with the Erie County Division of Sewerage Management, working around existing sanitary sewer lines, and if applicable, coordinating for replacement of sanitary sewer lines in one or more sections of the project area.
- Road reconstruction includes removal of the asphalt and concrete base.
- New curbs, including approximately 39 ADA-compliant curb ramps, will need to be installed and that work followed by road base grading and installation of an asphalt binder base.
- New ADA-complaint sidewalks will need to be installed, followed by topsoil restoration.
- An asphalt top course needs to be installed, followed by signage installation.
- It is anticipated the project would be broken into two phases, with the first phase comprised of the length of Oakwood Avenue from Olean Road to Walnut Street, a distance of approximately 3,200 feet.
- The timing for Phase I is expected to have construction commenced and completed within the 2019 construction season.
- The engineering firm will need to coordinate with the engineering and architectural consultants for the Town of Aurora concerning the reconstruction of the building at 575 Oakwood Avenue.

Proposals should include an estimate of the time, after a firm is selected for the work, when preliminary cost estimates for construction of the various project components shall be provided to the Village.

Compliance with all New York State laws governing public works projects for Village government entities is mandated. Grant funding from New York State has been applied for and, if awarded, may entail added legal requirements for the project utilizing grant funds.

The deadline for proposal submissions is October 26, 2018 at 10 a.m. Submissions shall be made to the Village Hall, 571 Main Street, East Aurora, NY 14052, with the outside envelope marked, "Oakwood Avenue Engineering RFP."
