**Mayor Kasprzak** opened the meeting at 7:02 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Trustee Weberg** moved to approve the Village Board minutes of April 13, 2010. Seconded by **Trustee Shea** and carried. **Trustee Biggs** voting against.

**Trustee Biggs** moved to approve the Village Board minutes of April 19, 2010. Seconded by **Trustee Shea** and carried.

**Trustee Scheer** moved to approve the Village Board minutes of May 3, 2010. Seconded by **Trustee Shea** and carried.

**Trustee Mercurio** moved to approve the payment of Abstract of Vouchers #45201-45313. Seconded by **Trustee Shea** and carried.

**PUBLIC HEARINGS & PRESENTATIONS:** (Certification of Publication attached at end of this record)

- **Special Permit Application for Hog Wild BBQ, 180 Main Street**, Kenneth Marth, applicant. Mr. Marth addressed the board: the hours of operation are currently planned for Tuesday through Saturday, 10am to 9pm, and limited hours on Saturday and Sunday. **Mayor Kasprzak** opened the public hearing at 7:07pm. Joe Spahn, 58 Buffalo Road asked if there was going to be outside barbequing and if they had adequate parking. Mr. Marth answered there will be no outside cooking and the parking lot is more than sufficient for a business with 30 seats. There were no further questions from the public. **Trustee Biggs** moved to close the public hearing at 7:10pm. Seconded by **Trustee Shea** and carried.
- **PRESENTATION: Mike Marino, CRA on Annual Storm Water MS4 Report to Board**. Written Annual Report has been filed with the Village. Mr. Marino explained what is contained in the report. He commented that the Village DPW has historically had "good housekeeping" of the village storm water system, well before the MS4 regulations were put in place. **Trustee West**

moved to authorize the Mayor to sign the annual report. Seconded by **Trustee Mercurio** and carried.

- **PRESENTATION:** Village Tree Board presented a draft of their proposed amendments to the current code, Chapter 240 "Trees". They asked the Board to review and consider. Discussion will continue at next work-session.

### **SPEAKERS & COMMUNICATIONS:**

*Five (5) people* to include Alex Bittner of South Grove, Brad Rogers of Emery Road, Ken Horton of Girard Avenue, Bert Smith, 176 Sycamore, Ed Koch, 381 Walnut spoke in favor of Little Loop in Hamlin Park, and the *Town Highway Superintendent* stated that his department maintains the parks and there was never a problem with any of the organizations that use Hamlin Park.

*Bill Hanavan*, Church Street, has an issue with the outdoor music at Riley Street Station, and the hay bales at the rink property are rotting and appear to be collapsing. He cited a health issue that he has which is exacerbated by the smell of rotting hay.

*Bob Warhus*, Hamlin Avenue commented that the new board room bench is intimidating.

### **OFFICIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

#### **Mayor Kasprzak**

- Read a proclamation in honor of Rev Dan Weir from St. Mathias who is retiring.
- Read a proclamation in honor of Vidlers 80<sup>th</sup> Birthday.
- Reported that he attended the NYCOM conference in Saratoga Springs.

**Trustee West** reported that he and Trustee Shea have been meeting with the Town on the Advisory Committee and the meetings have gone well and they are both optimistic that issues will be resolved soon.

**Trustee Biggs** stated that he was having a Sinking Ponds Committee meeting on Wednesday, May 26, 2010 at 7pm in the Red Room.

**Trustee Weberg** reported on the results of the Crosswalk Days, which went very well and seem to be getting the word out about crosswalk safety.

### **STAFF REPORTS:**

- **Building Department:** Bill Kramer reported that a letter is being sent from Boice Lydell's engineer in regard to his building on the Roycroft campus; Bill is also requesting the DPW to board up the building at 636 Fillmore Avenue and cut the weeds and grass. He also stated that this property was not on the auction block as the county had promised for May and several messages have been left at the county real property office in this regard, and the calls have not been returned. **Mayor Kasprzak** said he will contact **Legislator Mills** to get an answer to this question.
- **Police Department:** Monthly written report filed by the Police Chief.
- **DPW:** Superintendent Hoeh filed a written department report with the Board. (He was at the NYS Rural Water Conference.)
- **Main Street Special Project Coordinator:** Written report was filed with the Board by Mr. Gasiewicz.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

- **Application for Demolition of 111 Hamburg Street:** Trustee Biggs offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the applicant has filed Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form with this Board, a copy of which is included by reference and made a part hereof, relating to the proposed demolition of a three story frame structure located at 111 Hamburg Street, East Aurora, New York, filling in basement area to the elevation of the existing yard and adding topsoil and seed to areas disturbed; such demolition and fill not to disturb drainage.

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of Trustees carefully and fully reviewed Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form submitted by the applicant including the proposed Development Plan attached thereto, and the amendments and modifications made and filed with the Village by the applicant at the request of the Village, including, but not limited to, the comments and recommendations of the Village of East Aurora Planning Commission, at various Village work sessions and meetings, copies of the minutes of those meetings being incorporated by reference herein; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing properly noticed was held by the Village Board when comments and discussions were heard and considered for an against the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village SEQRA Intake Committee carefully and fully reviewed Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form submitted by applicant including the Development Plan attached thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, at said meeting, the SEQRA Intake Committee carefully and fully considered the discussions, comments and documentation presented for and against the project reflected in the minutes and attachments thereto of the various Village Board work sessions and meetings; the minutes of the public hearing; the minutes of the Village Planning Commission with attached comments and recommendations;

**WHEREAS**, the SEQRA Intake Committee after a hard look at the above referenced minutes, comments, discussions and documentation prepared a draft Part II of the Short Environmental

Assessment Form with a recommendation of the issuance of a Negative Declaration of environmental significance for submission to, and consideration by, the Village Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of Trustees at a work session on April 5, 2010 carefully and fully considered Part II of the Short Environmental Assessment Form prepared by the SEQRA Intake Committee, the recommendation of the SEQRA Committee and the above-referenced minutes, comments, discussions and documentation; all of which are incorporated by referenced herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of Trustees at this meeting upon a hard look and reasoned evaluation of the above-referred to information, comments and written documentation, including, but not limited to, Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form; comments and recommendations of the Planning Commission; the site/development plan, minutes of the various Village work sessions and meetings wherein the project was discussed; and having approved the completed Part II of the Short Environmental Assessment Form concerning potential environmental impact of the project as recommended by the Village SEQRA Intake Committee; all of which are incorporated by referenced herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board, after carefully and fully reviewing all the information, comments and written documentation in regard to the project, taking a hard look there at; and finding that there are no significant environmental impacts,

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it**

**RESOLVED**, that the Village Board of East Aurora as lead agency has determined that the proposed action described in the Short Environmental Assessment Form, submitted by the applicant, John Apgar for the demolition of structure located at 111 Hamburg Street, the addition of fill and seeding as set forth in the site/development plan as filed with the Village, included and incorporated by reference herein, will not have a significant environmental impact and a Draft Environmental Impact Statement will not be required to be required nor prepared.

**Discussion:**

**Trustee Scheer:** building is architecturally unsound and needs to be removed.

**Trustee Mercurio:** wondered if the board is setting a precedent by approving the demolition?

**Trustee Weberg:** stated the code requires a development plan, and another building on Main Street was denied a demolition permit because they did not have one.

**Trustee West:** commented that this was discussed by the planning commission as well, but in this particular case they did not believe it was reasonable to expect the new owner to restore the structure, due to its level of disrepair.

**Trustee Weberg** stated that the board should review this section of the code, and consider that these applications should also be submitted to the Historic Preservation Commission as well. This subject will be on the next work-session agenda.

AT 111 HAMBURG STREET, EAST AURORA, NEW YORK**

**WHEREAS**, John Apgar has submitted an application for development plan approval of the demolition of a three story frame structure located at 111 Hamburg Street, East Aurora, filling in basement area to elevation of existing yard and adding topsoil and seed to areas disturbed, such demolition and fill not to disturb drainage.

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Board of the Village of East Aurora having considered the application and submitted a recommendation and approval to the Village Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village's SEQRA Intake Committee considered the application and reviewed Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form submitted by the Applicant and completed Part 2 thereof on behalf of the Village, and it was the determination of the SEQRA Committee that the proposed development plan would have no significant environmental impact; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board received and carefully reviewed the development plan as submitted by the applicant and set forth in the Short Form Environmental Assessment Form, with the attachment thereto; and comments and recommendations of the Planning Commission ; along with the minutes of the various work sessions and meetings where at the project was discussed; the recommendations of the Village SEQR Intake Committee; and discussions, comments, and documentation presented for and against the project;

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has separately considered the environmental impacts of the project and issued a Negative Declaration of environmental significance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED**, by the Village Board as follows:

Pursuant to Section 285-51 of the Code of the Village of East Aurora, New York, the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of East Aurora, New York, does hereby issue this Special Use Permit to Owner, **Benderson Development**, permitting the use of premises located at 180 Main Street, East Aurora, New York, for a sandwich shop restaurant with out-door dining named "**Hog Wild BBQ**" and Kenneth Marth will be the owner/manager.

This Special Use Permit is based upon certain findings made by this Village Board, which findings are part of this record.

This Special Use Permit is subject to the permittee complying with any and all state, county and local laws, including, but not limited to, laws and regulations of the Erie County Department of Health, laws and regulations of the Village of East Aurora, and compliance with any and all provisions of the New York State Building and Fire Protection Code and the following conditions:

1. That the premise in question is located in a "C" Zoning District.

2. That a restaurants is permitted in a "C" Zoning District provided that a Special Use Permit for such activities is granted by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of East Aurora, New York.
3. That the premises at 180 Main Street is located within a Plaza setting, which is a complex of retail stores, and there are no residential uses made of property in the immediate vicinity of the premises in question.
4. That the **Hog Wild BBQ** will have approximately 46 seats with patio seating of 16 and is located as shown on the Development Plan with beer/wine being served.
5. The hours of operation shall be from Tuesday thru Saturday from 10AM – 7PM.
6. The Permit issued herein is issued to the permittee named above and can not be transferred.

§ 249-17 Handicapped parking — on-street and off-street.

[Added 5-5-2003 by L.L. No. 2-2003]

A. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any of the areas designated as places for handicapped parking unless the vehicle bears a special municipal parking permit issued under § 1203-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York or a registration and disabled person license plates issued under § 404-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York and such vehicle is being used for the transportation of a severely disabled or handicapped person.

B. Handicap parking permits will be issued by the Town of Aurora Town Clerk.  
[Amended 3-14-2006 by L.L. No. 1-2006]

C. All off street handicapped parking restrictions shall be posted in accordance with the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law and the applicable Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

D. Handicapped parking spaces shall be posted in accordance with § 1203-c, Subdivision 2(a) of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. If signs are not posted at each handicapped parking space, two signs shall be used for no more than three contiguous parking spaces.

E. The following areas are specifically designated handicapped parking for purposes of this section. Their designation is not intended to be all inclusive, nor limit those spaces designated as handicapped parking subject to a violation of this section or the applicable sections of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.
